

## Tiger Shroff, Janhvi Kapoor And Lakshya's Lag Ja Gale To Release On THIS Date In 2027



Lag Ja Gale, starring Tiger Shroff, Janhvi Kapoor, and Lakshya, has finally locked release date. The romantic drama is now set to hit theatres in 2027. The announcement has generated considerable buzz among moviegoers, as Lag Ja Gale marks the first on-screen collaboration between Tiger Shroff, Janhvi Kapoor, and Lakshya.

Taran Adarsh shared the announcement, "TIGER SHROFF – JANHVI KAPOOR – LAKSHYA: 'LAG JA GALE' RELEASE DATE LOCKED... Dharmia Productions, the producers of #LagJaGale, have finalised a Summer 2027 release for the film: 14 May 2027. #TigerShroff, #JanhviKapoor, and #Lakshya star in this intense action entertainer, directed by Raj Mehta." Fans also reacted.

As per Mid-Day, the update has it that the shoot of Lag Ja Gale has been extended till October due to Lakshya's look-change requirement. The source has shared with the portal that Lakshya has a soft look in Chand Mera Dil, and for Lag Jaa Gale, he had to take on a rugged

avatar, for which he will have to grow his hair, there is a delay in the shoot.

The source elaborated, "While filming Lag Jaa Gale, Lakshya had to shoot for a few scenes of Chand Mera Dil. His looks in both films are different. He had to not only cut his hair, but also trade the rugged avatar of Lag Jaa Gale for the soft look that he has in Chand Mera Dil. Now, he will have to grow his hair and then resume the actioner's shoot."

The film brings Lakshya and Tiger Shroff together in an action-heavy narrative built around revenge. Earlier, the portal had shared that the clash between their characters will form a major attraction, with high-energy sequences planned through the schedule. The story also builds drama around Janhvi Kapoor's character, creating a triangle at the centre of the plot.

Originally, Lag Jaa Gale was announced as a directorial venture for Karan Johar during his 50th birthday celebrations in 2022. Johar stepped away from directing the film later and is now attached as producer.

Tiger Shroff last appeared in Baaghi 4, directed by A. Harsha and produced by Sajid Nadiadwala. The action thriller followed naval officer Ronny, who begins to hallucinate about a woman named Alisha after an accident and becomes embroiled in conflict with a criminal network led by Chacko, played by Sanjay Dutt. The film featured Shreyas Talpade, Harnaaz Sandhu, Sonam Bajwa, Saurabh Sachdeva, and Upendra Limaye in key roles. Janhvi Kapoor recently starred opposite Ram Charan in Peddi. The film has been facing immense backlash over the sexualisation of Janhvi's character. However, despite the criticism and mixed reactions, the Buchi Babu Sana directorial has been performing well at the box office. Lakshya was last seen in Chand Mera Dil with Ananya Panday.

With its latest earnings, Hai Jawani Toh Ishq Hona Hai has taken its India net collection to

₹23.08 crore. Its India gross collection currently stands at ₹27.53 crore.

About the film's storyline

At the heart of the film is Jass, played by Varun Dhawan. The story follows his complicated personal life after his wife Bani, portrayed by Mrunal Thakur, pushes for a divorce, claiming she cannot keep up with his sexual appetite. Jass later finds love again with Preet, played by Pooja Hegde. Things spiral into complete chaos when both women become pregnant and he discovers that he is the father of both children.

Produced by Tips Films, the movie also features Mouni Roy, Kubbra Sait, and Rakesh Bedi in important roles.

Apart from its box office journey, the film has also found itself at the centre of a controversy involving veteran producer Vashu Bhagnani. He has raised concerns over the alleged recreation and use of songs associated with his films without permission. Puja Entertainment also argued that the title itself is linked to the song Ishq Sonai Hai and demanded not only the removal of the songs from the film and promotional material but also a change in the film's title.

## Shraddha Kapoor And Director Laxman Utekar's Biopic Eetha Locks Release Date

Shraddha Kapoor's upcoming biographical drama Eetha has officially locked its release date. Directed by filmmaker Laxman Utekar, the film is expected to bring an inspiring real-life story to the big screen, with Shraddha stepping into a challenging and emotionally demanding role. The film is all set to hit the screens on this Raksha Bandhan, i.e August 28.

Trade Analyst Taran Adarsh announced the film and its release date, "Xclusiv... DINESH VIJAN – LAXMAN UTEKAR REUNITE: SHRADDHA KAPOOR STARS IN 'EETHA' – RELEASE DATE LOCKED... Following the blockbuster success of #Chhaava, Dinesh Vijan and Laxman Utekar reunite for #Eetha – a bold and emotionally charged film that features #ShraddhaKapoor in a powerful, author-backed role. The release date has been locked: 28 Aug 2026 [#RakshaBandhan]. The film also features #RandeepHooda and #MohdZee-shanAyyub in pivotal roles." Shraddha Kapoor reportedly



wrapped up shooting for Eetha in May. The much-anticipated biopic is based on legendary Tamasha artiste Vithabai Narayangaonkar. The film, which focusses on her extraordinary journey between 1940 and 1990, concluded its shoot with a grand montage song sequence filmed in Bhor, Maharashtra. As reported by Mid-day, on

May 5, the makers reached its finish line with a massive montage song, featuring Kapoor and a crowd of 800 people, shot in Bhor, Maharashtra. "The final song has a montage that chronicles the journey of Shraddha's character from a young woman to her brush with fame and finally how she falls on hard times. Like the remaining num-

bers, this too has been choreographed by Vaibhavi Merchant," said a source.

The portal also informed that it was the end of the 60-day schedule that began in March. The team shot in Madh Island in Mumbai, Solapur, Aundhewadi, Satara, and Nashik.

In November, 2025, Shraddha Kapoor started shooting for Eetha. Directed by Laxman Utekar, the project marks Shraddha's first collaboration with the filmmaker and is being produced by Dinesh Vijan's Maddock Films. The news spread rapidly after a photo of the film's clapboard, titled Eetha, went viral on social media, sparking excitement among fans. Eetha promises to showcase Shraddha in one of her most intense and performance-driven roles to date. The actress, who last appeared in Stree 2: Sarkate Ka Aatank (2024), has been selective with her recent projects, focusing on scripts that allow her to explore diverse characters.
